1. Effective immediately, Marine Corps Base Camp Blaz (MCBCB) has implemented a mandatory Military Family Housing assignment for Service Members (Marines and Navy) permanently assigned to the unit. This policy is not retroactive. The intent of this policy is to maximize the occupancy and utilization of the government housing on Andersen Air Force Base (AAFB) for newly assigned permanent personnel at MCBCB.
2. Accompanied Marines with permanent change of station orders to MCBCB, and designated key and essential personnel eligible for on-base housing shall accept housing facilities as offered by the Housing Office at Andersen Air Force Base (AAFB). The AAFB Housing Team will determine the eligibility for on-base housing for Marines and Sailors assigned to MCBCB. The eligibility will depend on the type of home (junior enlisted, senior enlisted, company grade, field grade, etc.) and availability of the home. MCBCB inbound personnel should contact the housing office in advance to ensure proper planning prior to arrival on Guam.
3. Marines can request an Exception to Policy. Enclosure (1) provides an avenue of approach to personnel not satisfied with the housing opportunity. The ETP is not automatic for approval or disapproval. Instead, each request will be reviewed, and a decision will be provided to the Service Member on a case-by-case basis.
